Alaska's Inside Passage is renowned for its magnificence and proximity to untouched wilderness, and wonders of nature. Ancient glaciers glint majestically, as pristine snow–capped mountains soar into the open sky. The deep harbours and frontier towns welcome visitors with open arms, eager to reveal their riches. The possibilities are endless, inviting excursions of untold discovery and delight. Big, Bold and impossibly beautiful, Alaska stretches beyond the imagination.

Sailing into Anchorage (Seward), is a fantastic way to get up close and personal, to Alaska's scenic glaciers. Departing the pier by coach, you will arrive in nearby Kenai Fjords National Park, for a tour of Exit Glacier. One of dozens of glaciers spilling down from the massive Harding Icefield (named for President Harding who visited here), Exit Glacier covers over 10 square kilometres, and is easily accessible. It was known as Resurrection Glacier until the late 1960s, when a group of adventurous mountaineers exited here, becoming the first ever to cross the imposing Harding Icefield. Standing near the base of the dense, bluish mass of ice, you may hear it crackle and groan as it impercentibly inches along



Leaving Exit Glacier behind, and arriving back in Seward, is the perfect time for a tour of the inspirational Alaska Sealife Center, the state's only public aquarium and ocean wildlife rescue centre. There is a wide variety of indigenous wildlife here that is housed in naturalistic habitats. Some that you may see include puffins, octopus, sea lions and seals. Many of them are being rehabilitated in hopes of returning them to the wild. You may also observe the centre's scientists, who are pioneering research on Alaska's marine ecosystems and especially the animal populations that are declining.
