BANGKOK (LAEM CHABANG) -THAILAND

Wat Pho is a must-see, famous for its huge gold-plated reclining Buddha and renowned massage school. PHUKET - THAILAND

Phuket, Thailand's largest island is often dubbed as the pearl of the Andaman, or the pearl of the south. Its natural resources, rocky peninsular, limestone cliffs, white powdery beaches, tranquil broad bays and tropical in-land forests contribute to making it the South's wealthiest, busiest, most visited and most popular island and province.


SHANGHAI (BAOSHAN) - CHINA









